- India's creator economy was **\$976 million** in 2023,
- It is projected to reach \$3.9 billion by 2030 at a **22% CAGR**.

Video Creators: Content creators who produce and share videos, ranging from short-form clips to long-form documentaries, on platforms like YouTube, TikTok, and Instagram.

Podcasters : Podcasters are individuals who create and share audio content, typically in the form of episodes or series, on topics ranging from news to entertainment.

Bloggers & Writers :Content creators who write and publish articles, blogs, or newsletters, often focusing on specific niches and monetize through ads, sponsorships, or paid subscriptions.

Educators & Coaches :Creators who offer educational content, training, and coaching, ranging from online courses to live mentorship sessions, often on platforms like Udemy, Teachable, and Patreon.

Game Streamers & Esports Creators: Gamers who stream their gameplay live or create video content around gaming, often earning through live donations, sponsorships, and platform revenue

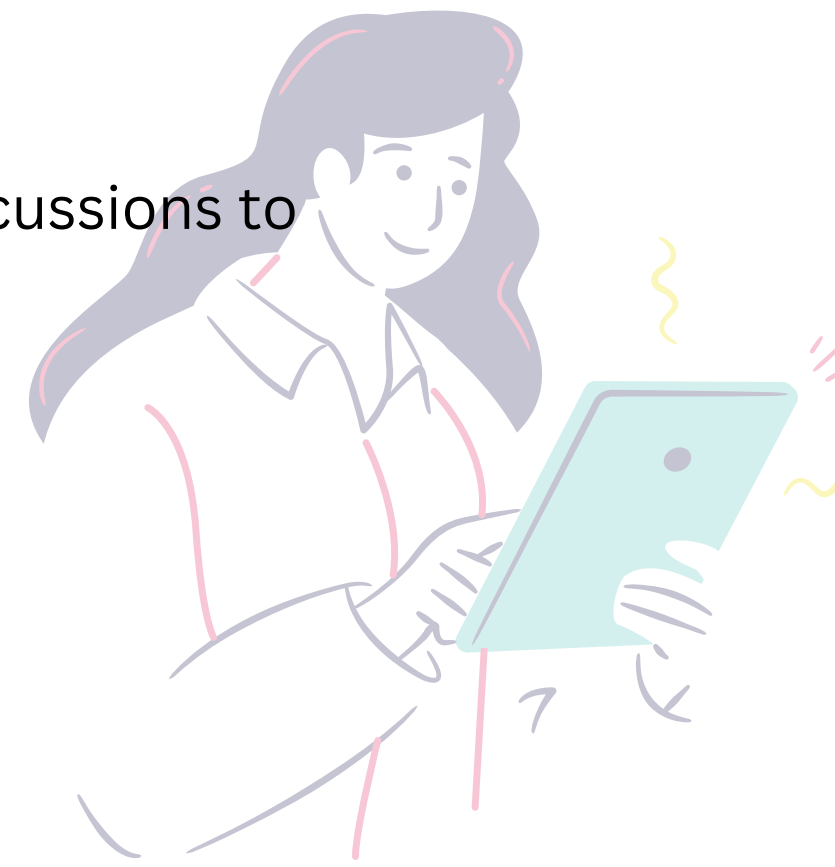

- **Features:** Personalized podcast recommendations, Multi-device compatibility.

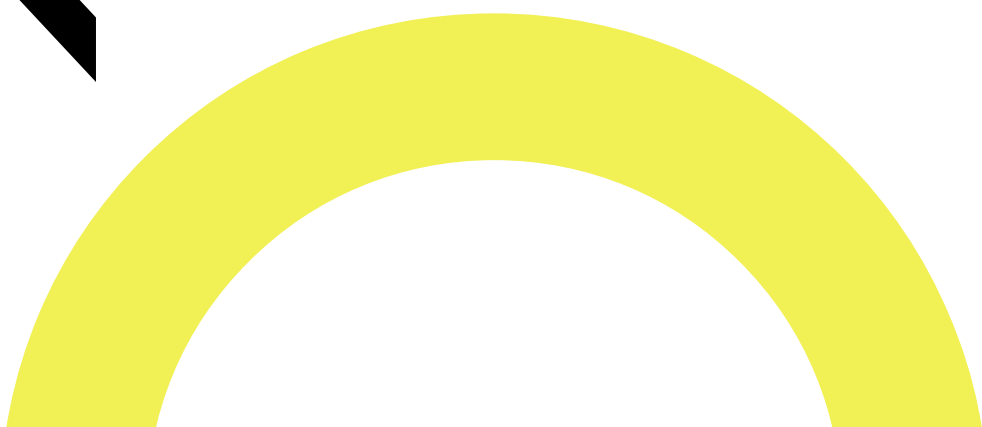
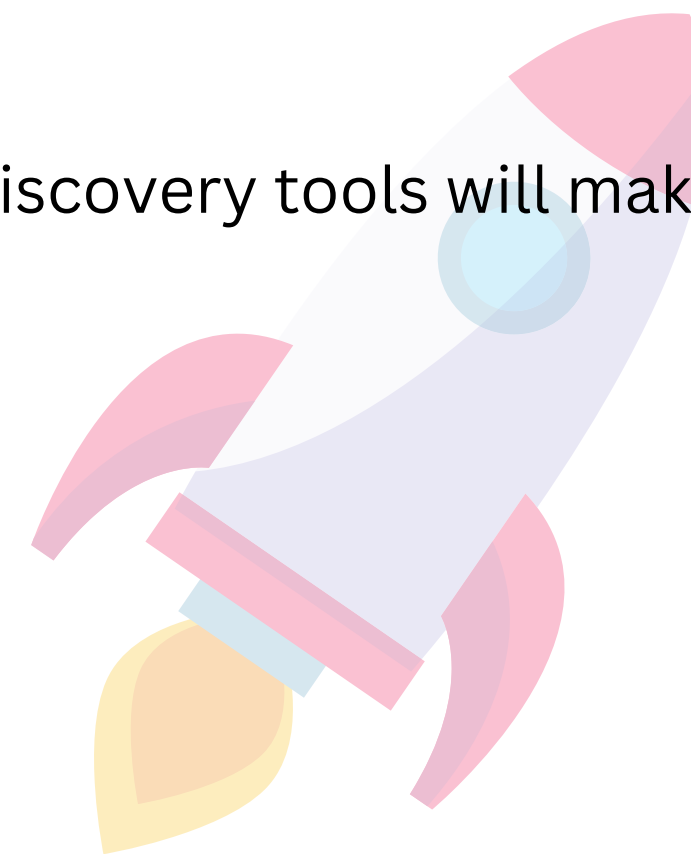
RECENT TRENDS IN THE MARKET

- ◆ **Integration of Interactive & Social Features** : Platforms are adding polls, Q&A, and community discussions to enhance listener engagement.







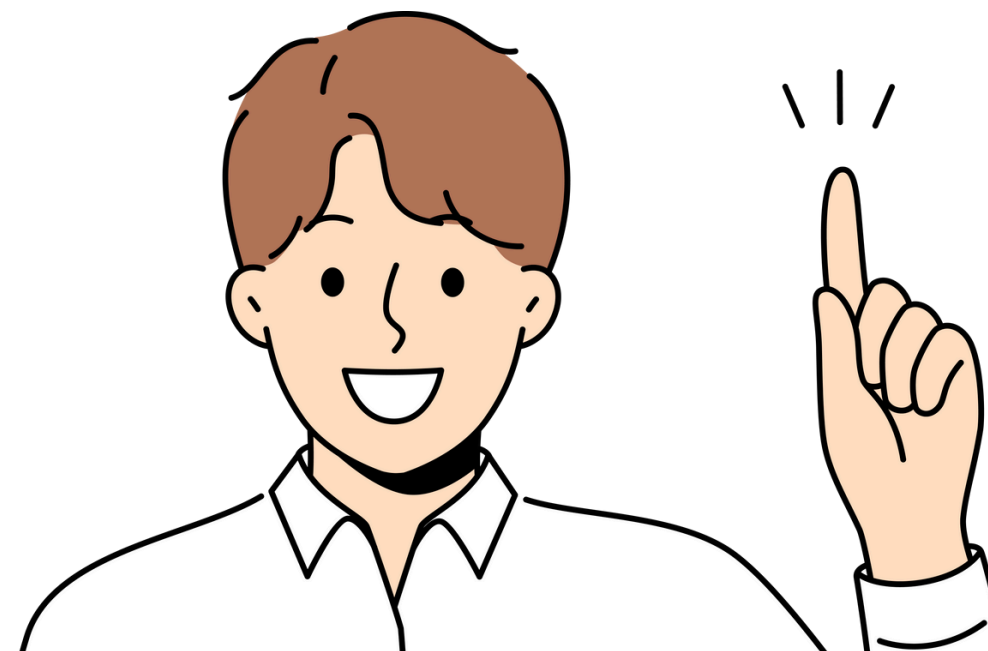
WHAT DOES THE FUTURE LOOK LIKE?
