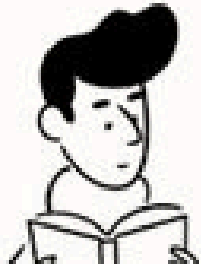

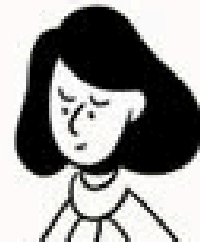

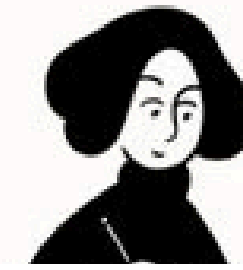

Sign Up & Permissions

- Sign up with Google, Microsoft, or email.
- Connect your calendar (Google/Microsoft) to auto-join meetings.
- Grant permissions to access meetings and recordings.

Personal Settings

- Choose transcription language.
- Set preferences: auto-join meetings, summary format, sharing settings.
- Optionally connect Slack, Notion, Zoom, or CRM.

Completing the first task

3

Start and Join the meeting

- Host initiates the meeting on Zoom, Google Meet, or MS Teams.
- Read AI automatically joins or can be manually invited via a meeting link.
- Live transcription begins instantly, with clear speaker labels shown.

4

Post meeting

- AI auto-generates a meeting summary with key points, action items, and decisions.
- Sentiment analysis and talk-time engagement metrics are included.
- A detailed report is sent via email and added to your dashboard.

Regular Usage

Dashboard

- See daily/weekly “For You” insights.
- Access transcripts, summaries, action items.
- Upload recordings or past meetings for context.

Collaboration

- Share meeting summaries via link or Slack.
- Export content to Notion, Confluence, or PDF.
- Assign action items from meeting notes to task managers.

Search Copilot

- Search across meetings: “What did we decide on X?”
- AI pulls up the relevant clip, transcript, and speaker.

Playback

- Replay meetings with transcript sync.
- Use mobile app (iOS) for summaries and insights too.

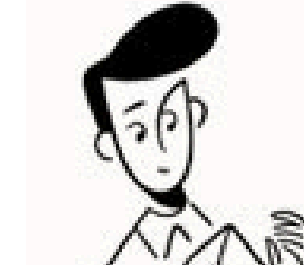

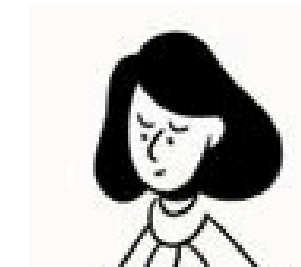
Integration Challenges



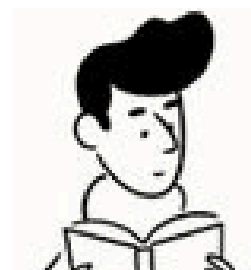
While Read AI promises multiple integrations with platforms like Google Meet, Zoom, Jira, Slack, etc, users faced challenges setting up or using these integrations effectively.

→ Customer Support Issues

Several customers expressed frustration over slow response times and unresolved issues with customer support.



Limited Customization



Some users expressed the desire for more customization options in terms of summary formats, report layouts, and integrations.

→ Dependency on Specific Platforms

While Read AI integrates with Zoom, Google Meet and such, users who rely on other meeting platforms may find it limiting.
